

Good for you ... and good for Sweden.

When you perform your military service, you help Sweden continue to be a safe country. But there are also other benefits and rights for you that are good to be aware of.

→ Right to approved leave from studies

If you have been conscripted, you can apply for approved leave from your studies. You retain your study place and can start or resume your studies after basic training.

→ Daily remuneration

You will receive remuneration of **SEK 146** for each day of military service, which corresponds to approximately **SEK 4.380** per month tax-free.

→ Training bonus

On completing your training, you will receive a bonus equivalent to the sum of the daily remuneration you have already received, i.e. if you have completed nine months of training, you will receive $9 \times 4,380$, which equals a bonus of **SEK 39,420**.

→ Travel to and from home

Many of your weekends will be free, and then the Swedish Armed Forces will cover your travel expenses to and from home.

→ Free board and lodging

You will receive free food and accommodation while you are a conscript.

→ Paid scholastic aptitude tests

The Swedish Armed Forces will bear the cost of two scholastic aptitude tests, if the test days coincide with your basic training.

Basic military training for conscripts is conducted at several bases around the country. The focus of training depends on your posting.

This information applies to those who turn 18 years of age in 2023.



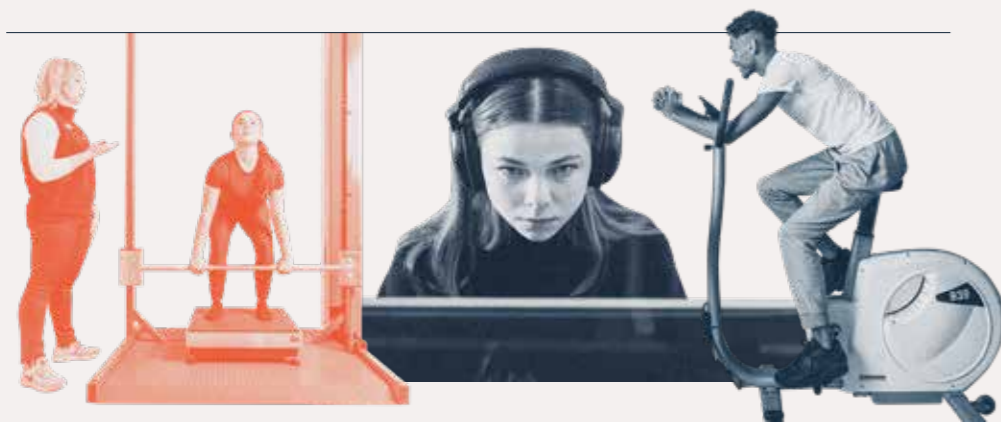
Hello!

If you receive this brochure, you will soon have to respond to the mustering questionnaire. The brochure contains important information about your obligations with regard to the total defence service and the defence of Sweden.

➔ In the year you turn 18 years of age, you are required to complete a mustering questionnaire on our website. You do this once you have received a separate letter containing login details at the beginning of the year.

We then use your answers to assess whether you should be called to muster. If you are called to muster, and pass it, you can be enlisted in basic military training for conscripts. If you are enlisted, you must attend the training programme.

Conscription is about defending Sweden's long-standing peace, freedom and democracy, and thus ensuring that Sweden is and remains an independent country.

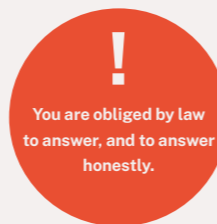


STEP BY STEP: HOW MUSTERING WORKS ➔

Mustering — step by step

1 Complete the mustering questionnaire JANUARY-FEBRUARY 2023

The mustering questionnaire contains questions about you, your health and your physical condition. Based on your answers, we will assess whether you should be called to muster. Sometime during the coming weeks, you will receive a letter containing your login details. **When you receive the letter containing your login details, you have two weeks to log in and answer the questions.** You have an obligation to answer honestly. If you do not respond, you may have to pay a fine. There may also be legal sanctions if you give untrue answers.



2 Mustering notification MARCH-APRIL 2023

At the end of March, you will find out whether or not you will be called to muster. If you are called, you must report to us and muster. If you are not called to muster, but are still interested in undergoing basic military training for conscripts, you can submit your own application once you have been notified of the decision and turned 18 years of age. You can learn more about how this works at pliktverket.se. Mustering takes place from May 2023 until April 2024, and you will receive the invitation about two months before it is time for you to muster.

3 Mustering MAY 2023-APRIL 2024

You will receive the summons to report to mustering about two months before it is time for you to muster. This will state where and when you should muster. Once you have received the summons, go to "My page" at pliktverket.se and confirm that you have received it.

Mustering takes one or two days and involves tests, medical examinations, assessments and interviews. Among those you will meet during mustering are a nurse, a doctor and a psychologist. If you fail to pass one of the stages, you will be excused military service and you may return home. Your results show whether you have the necessary prerequisites for completing basic military training as a conscript.

Mustering takes place in Stockholm, Gothenburg and Malmö. We cover the cost of travel, food and accommodation.

4 Enlistment

At the end of the mustering process, you will meet an enlistment officer, who will match you with available postings based on your results. Before you return home from mustering, you will receive a preliminary decision on whether you will be conscripted to undergo basic military training and, if so, where.



You will receive your final enlistment decision within four months of mustering.

5 Basic military training for conscripts SUMMER 2024 ONWARDS

If you are conscripted, your basic training will take between 6 and 15 months.

There are many different postings – from chef to combat vehicle driver, minesweeper and mechanic.
